To combat the cost of higher education, we are committed to doing all that we can to help our future deaconesses to graduate with as little student debt as possible – thus, helping to ensure that they may focus on their first calls without the worry of making debt payments. Our donors have stepped up to help with this. Owing to their generosity, as they have been moved by the Spirit of our Lord, they have made it possible for each residential student who applies for financial aid to be guaranteed not to have to pay out of pocket for any portion of her thition expenses.

Each student is expected to maintain her grades and participate in the financial aid opportunities the Seminary offers. This includes participating in the Seminary's Adopt-A-Student program and applying for aid from her home district and home congregation as well as scholarships from outside of the Seminary. After all of the aid from these sources is received, any shortfall in the student's balance for tuition will be covered by a grant directly from the Seminary.

This policy is in effect for the 2024-25 academic year and is expected to remain so long as donor support makes it possible. Such donor support includes gifts from individuals, LCMS districts and LCMS congregations. The success of this initiative, and our ability to greatly reduce the debt of all ministerial formation students, is directly dependent on the continued support from all of these partners.

You may have questions concerning the cost of seminary education as your congregation considers how to assist your student at Concordia Seminary. Here are average expected expenses for residential students in the 2024-25 academic year:

- Regular Tuition \$24,840
- Room and Board (single) \$11,150
- Books and Supplies \$1,100
- Internship Tuition \$16,200
- Campus Housing (married) \$12,150
- Health Insurance (single) \$4,320
