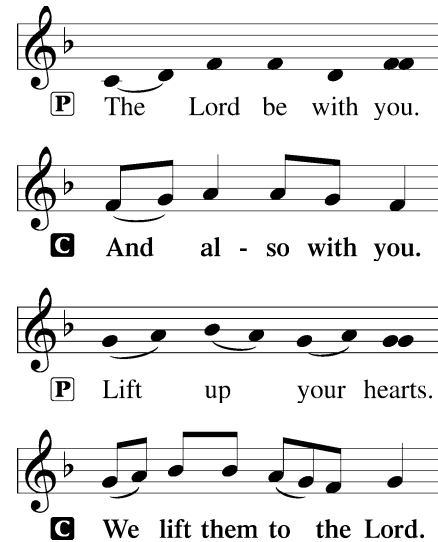
PRAYER OF THE CHURCH

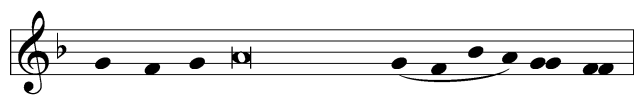

C Amen. Come, Lord Jesus.

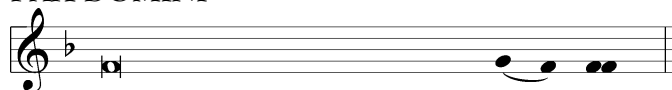

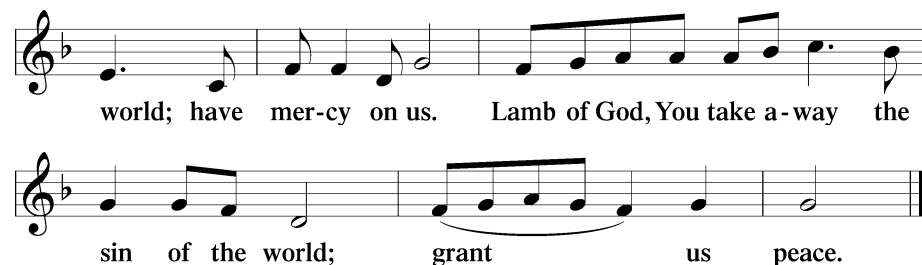

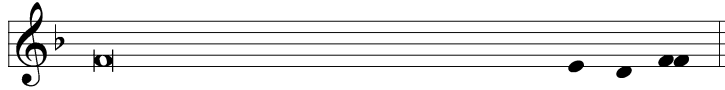
